Applications are open for companies to participate in the South African National Pavilion at the ANUGA International Food Products Exhibition scheduled from 7 October to 11 October 2023 in Cologne, Germany.

The following financial support will be offered to qualifying South African exporters to introduce South African products into foreign markets, in a cost-effective manner:

- Exhibition space and booth rental costs
- Freight-forwarding of display material
- Air travel assistance up to R20 000.00 for small, medium and micro enterprises (SMMEs) and black-owned enterprises (BOEs) only
- Daily subsistence allowance of R3 500.00 per day SMMEs and BOEs only

The South Africa National Pavilion at the ANUGA International Food Products Exhibition 2023 event will focus on processed foods, non-alcoholic beverages, preserved foods, spices, soups, deep-frozen products, cured meat, health and organic products, sweets, seafood, and gourmet food products.
