WHO IS CIPC?


- CIPC is an agency of the Department of Trade and Industry and Competition (the dtic) established in May 2011 by the Companies Act 71 of 2008



WHAT IS COPYRIGHT?

Copyright is a bundle of exclusive legal rights concerned with the protection of literary and artistic works, often referred to just as "works".


Copyright gives an author/creator of work a bundle of exclusive rights over his/her work for a limited but lengthy rights


□ These rights are economic & moral

WHAT IS A PATENT

- A patent gives an exclusive right granted for an invention, which is a product or a process that provides a new way of doing something, or offers a new technical solution to a problem
- The patent provides protection for an invention to the owner of the patent
- Patent protection means that the invention cannot be commercially made, distributed or sold without the owner's consent
- □ A patent is in force for 20 years, provided that it is renewed annually from third year

WHAT IS A DESIGN?

- A design is the shape, form, appearance, pattern, ornamentation or configuration of a product or article
- There are two types of designs that can be registered:

Aesthetic Design

- Has to be new and original
- Beauty is in its shape, configuration or ornamentation
- Must be able to be produced by an industrial process

Functional Design

- Has to be new and not commonplace
- Where the shape or configuration is necessitated by the function
- Must be able to be produced by an industrial process
