#### **QUESTION NO. 2234**

**Mr M J Cuthbert (DA) to ask the Minister of Trade, Industry and Competition:**

- (1) Whether, with reference to his reply to question 1707 on 21 August 2020, he has been informed that a certain company (name furnished) received R64,431,576.24 from the Industrial Development Corporation (IDC) through its Black Industrialists Programme and that on the National Lotteries Commission's website it clearly states that a certain person (name and details furnished) is a director of the specified company; if not, what is the position in this regard; if so,
- (2) whether he has found this to constitute a conflict of interest; if not, why not; if so, what are the relevant details? NW2806E

Following the question posed, I requested the Department to advise on the matter. I am advised that the Companies Intellectual Property Commission (CIPC) directorship records does not contain the name of the said person against the record for United Industrial Cables, either as an active director or a resigned director.
