## DEPARTMENT OF TRADE, INDUSTRY AND COMPETITION CALL FOR NOMINATION OF CANDIDATES TO SERVE AS NON-EXECUTIVE MEMBERS ON THE BOARD OF THE SOUTH AFRICAN BUREAU OF STANDARDS (SABS)

The Standards Act, 2008 (Act No. 8 of 2008), established the SABS to provide for the development, promotion and maintenance of standardisation and quality in connection with commodities and the rendering of related conformity assessment services.

The Minister of Trade, Industry and Competition invites nominations of persons to appoint as Non-Executive Members to the Board of the SABS.

**Personal requirements in respect of Non-Executive Members:** Candidates should have experience in finance, business management, international or foreign standardization and technical infrastructure matters • Further, candidates should have a minimum of 5 years' Board related experience.

**Disqualification from membership:** In terms of Section 8 of the Standards Act, 2008, candidates may not be appointed or continue to serve as a member of the Board if they:

- a) are an un-rehabilitated insolvent;
- b) have at any time been convicted of an offence involving dishonesty;
- c) have, as a result of improper conduct, been removed from an office of trust; or
- d) have been declared by a court to be mentally ill or unfit.

**Term of office of the Non-Executive Members:** Non-Executive Members hold office for a period not exceeding five (5) years.

**Remuneration of Non-Executive Members:** Non-Executive Members will be remunerated according to the remuneration rates as determined and published by the National Treasury.

**Note:** Nominations must be submitted in writing and contain the following information: Detailed Curriculum Vitae that includes membership of all boards the nominee currently serves on or has served on in the past, motivation for the appointment and certified copies of identity document and qualifications obtained.

The following mandatory forms obtainable from the dtic website, <http://www.thedtic.gov.za/board-vacancies/> must be completed, signed and submitted: A nomination and acceptance form (Form 1A) • A form relating to the particulars of the nominee (Form 1B) • A consent and indemnity form and a register of interest information sheet.

**In addition: Background verification, including social media checks, criminal record and citizenship checks, will form part of the selection process • It is the nominee's responsibility to have foreign qualifications verified by the South African Qualifications Authority (SAQA) Nominations may be posted to the Registry Office, Department of Trade, Industry and Competition, Private Bag X84, Pretoria.
