SUBJECT: INTERPRETATION OF PARAGRAPHS 4 AND 7 OF THE SSAS

1. PURPOSE

1.1 To provide clarity on the following paragraphs of the SSAS guidelines:

2. INTERPRETATION

2.1 Under **paragraph 4.2** of the guideline, all applicants must meet the criteria stipulated in the following paragraphs and not just two criteria:

Pragraphs 4.2.2.2 and 4.2.2.3 and 4.2.2.5.

- 2.2 In paragraphs 7.1.12, 7.2.9, "disabled persons" shall mean "people with disabilities".
- 2.3 In **paragraph 7.2.3**, payment of transport of samples where relevant, will only be paid if the following three conditions are met:
 - (a) claims will only be paid after the show/event.
 - (b) claims must be related to the approved show/event.
 - (c) claims to be submitted within 30 days after the show/event.
- 2.4 In **paragraph 7.2.9**, digital connectivity (data) cost can only be considered if the following three requirements are met:
 - (a) Connectivity cost to be excluded from exhibition cost and treated as a stand alone activity.
 - (b) Maximum of 100% of the cost, capped at Ten Thousand Rand (R10 000) per event.
 - (c) Three qoutations to be submitted at application stage.
- 2.5 In **paragraph 7.2.9**, the total exhibition cost will be a maximum of 100% of the cost, capped at Two Hundred and Ninenty Thousand Rand (R290 000).
