The Department of Trade, Industry and Competition (**the dtic**) invites interested companies to participate in an Outward Selling Mission (OSM) to Accra, (Ghana), and Lagos, (Nigeria), from **22 to 29 October 2025.** The objective of the OSM is to facilitate market access for South African value-added goods and services in Ghana and Nigeria. Planned activities during the OSM include a Business Seminar, Business-to-Business meetings and site visits.

# Targeted sectors: Mining, Infrastructure and Agriculture and Agro-processing.

Entities that wish to apply for EMIA funding to participate in this event must:

- Have been in business for at least two years;
- Acquired proven business track record;
- Be competitive in the South African market;
- Be export-ready and or have exported previously;
- Have the capacity to timeously supply any export orders resulting from the OSM; and
- Have a valid and active tax clearance certificate.

## the dtic will provide:

- Economy class return airfare up to a pre-determined maximum amount;
- Daily accommodation up to a pre-determined maximum amount (bed and breakfast only); and
- Excess luggage allowance for samples up to R2,500 per delegate.
