Land Availability Agreement

- (1) Whether the Land Availability Agreement with the assistance of the National Project Management Unit (PMU) has been (a) signed and (b) secured; if not, what is the position in this regard; if so, what are the relevant details;
- (2) whether an agreement has been entered into with a certain company (details furnished) for the proposed rail siding; if not, what is the position in this regard; if so, what are the relevant details;
- (3) whether the National PMU is involved in this regard; if not, why not; if so, what are the relevant details? CW491E

REPLY

- (1) (a)&(b) Yes, the Land Availability Agreement with the assistance of the National Project Management Unit (PMU), referred to as the Industrial Zones Programme (IZP), has been signed and secured. The IZP facilitated the conclusion of a Long-Term Lease Agreement. The Agreement has been registered with the Deeds Office.
- (2) The IZP confirmed, that the SEZ has entered into an agreement with DP World. The agreement includes the building of the railway siding.

- (3) The IZP provides technical advisory and support to Nkomazi SEZ. The rail siding will be developed by DP World.

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
