




UK Government donates R50m to South Africa's Solidarity Fund for women beneficiary projects

The most recent prioritisation exercise of the UK's International COVID19 response has allocated up to £2.15m UK Pounds (ca. R50m) to support South Africa's efforts via the Solidarity Fund

The British High Commission to SA has noted that they would be interested in these funds being deployed to support the Fund's efforts in responding to *GBV but also* supporting women's economic empowerment and SMEs.

These are areas that the UK has always been keen to support and which are important aspects of their COVID19 response and recovery plans.

The donation will form part of two existing Humanitarian Response Pillar projects namely the second Gender Based Violence intervention and and Farming Input Vouchers.

The R50m allocation will be made as follows:

- GBV2 = R25m (R75m total project envelope)
- Farming Input Voucher = R25m (R100m total project envelope. The project is targeted at 66% women household/subsistence farmers in rural areas, fulfilling the UK government's request of supporting women's economic empowerment and SMEs.

ANNOUNCEMENT OUTLINE

- The announcement is envisaged to take the form of a trilateral effort between the Government of SA, The Solidarity Fund and the British High Commission (BHC) to South Africa.
- Signing ceremony/event planned for Monday, 14 September 2020 at 2pm and to be followed immediately by issue of press statement.
- The Deputy Minister of International Relations and Cooperation, Mr Alvin Botes and the Deputy Minister of Trade and Industry, Ms. Nomalungelo Gina will be present at signing.
